A defining moment!

The grapes come with giants.

“Israel Refuses to Enter Canaan”

v. 1 – they cried all night! So many of our ‘crisis’ are because we do not believe God.

28 Say to them, ‘As I live,’ says the Lord, ‘just as you have spoken in My hearing, so I will do to you:

31 But your little ones, whom you said would be victims, I will bring in, and they shall know the land which you have despised. 33 And your sons shall be shepherds in the wilderness forty years, and bear the brunt of your infidelity, until your carcasses are consumed in the wilderness. (Nu 14:31-33).

v. 21 – “All the earth”

- Two theories on how this happens
Context of this: their disobedience and unbelief!
“As I live...”
“In spite of your unfaithfulness, I will have a faithful people, on whom I can pour out My glory.”

Our Response

(1) We have to have a different spirit

*But My servant Caleb, **because he has a different spirit** in him and has followed Me fully, I will bring into the land where he went, and his descendants shall inherit it. – Num. 14:24*

It's the spirit of **faith**

¹³*And since we have the same spirit of faith, according to what is written, “I believed and therefore I spoke,” we also believe and therefore speak,*

Notice that its *different!*

What are you saying and praying under pressure? (“therefore we speak”)

(2) You have to choose the right company
