Review:

Mandate from God for prosperity

(Gen 1:26-28)

Mandate - An authoritative command

God created man (in His image) to be His kingdom agent to rule and subdue the rest of creation.

Prospered to Bless

Duet 8:18 *'And you shall remember the Lord your God for it is He who gives you the **power** to get wealth that He may **establish His covenant**, which He swore to your fathers to this day.'*

Power - Koach (Ko-akh) - Vigor, Strength, force, capacity, generally means "capacity" or "ability" whether physical, mental or spiritual.

This text tells us that wealth should exist to establish and verify the covenant. It should not be squandered selfishly.

Wealth puts us in a position of influence for the kingdom of God, by giving of our time, talents, and treasures

Gen. 11:25

Because Abraham understood this truth, looking into eternity, he chose to live a purpose driven life.

On the hand Lot, although raised by Abraham, did not have the same since of purpose, therefore he drifted through life living only for the present moment

Abraham lived in the center of the covenant, living an overcoming, prosperous life.

Lot lived on the edge of the covenant, needing to be rescued because of selfish chooses.
